• Link	Lexical fields - linked vocab grammatical links making connections to English / other language. context of own life / experiences links to prior topics
Compare	
• Same or different	model text - WAGOLL vs WABOLL narrow reading / parallel texts - find the differences. spot the difference odd one out - vocabulary activities
Extend	
• Develop • Add	Give simple sentence - add to it with x connective / vocab / structure. Build a sentence collaboratively ↳ "I went to market" style activity. Substitution type activity - add to complexity by varying vocab.
Create	
• Write / Speak • Invent • Be independent	Spontaneous speak. "pass the paper" - build on somebody else's activity.
